Rev Geo Merriam The Drainage Report

Mr Jeary reported that he had visited persons whose premises would have Junction pipes with the District Councils drain. Mr Reeve at first demurred to entertaining the Councils proposition but subsequently acceded to its requirements. Mr Hoppers drain the Council report as being satisfactory.

Mrs Lamberts the Reverse, having only a stone pipe to act as an out-let for the drainage. That was being remedied by construction of Trap & improved piping. He requested permission of Council for Clerk to write Mr J Rising of Holesby in reference to drain from Mrs Tungsates premises and call his attention to its present condition before connecting with main.

With respect to Mr Suttons demand for a Trap as reported by Councillor Bracey the Council not agree to it. In absence of Mr Blyth he could only state it was arranged to connect by a 6 inch piping from main to Air shaft at the Councils cost, and to agree the annual payment of 6 for leave to run the Air shaft at gable of Mr Suttons Cottage. Councillor Bracey stated that Mr Suttons wishes for a trap could be met at a cost not exceeding 5/-

Mr Warnes suggested that the larger ~~trap~~ formerly ~~used~~ in use in Black Street be utilized on the same main drain

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It was proposed by Mr. Johnson seconded by Mr. Love

That the Council voluntarily pay such sum for a speedy completion of Contract.

Which proposition was carried unanimously

The Vice Chairman moved for leave to extend the contract for the White Tree drain so as to cover 22 feet across entrance to Mr. B. W. Risings drive, to be at same rate as other portion Mr. Grumble seconded

Agreed to.

The Chairman having read a letter from Mr. W. Burleigh complaining of the state of the Pond near his residence, the Clerk was ordered to acknowledge receipt of same, saying the matter was being attended to.

That Messrs Blyth Jeary & Love do act as a Sub-Committee to extend the piping of drains to the Ponds and to improve the general appearance of same by planting Willows. Upon proposition being accepted Mr. Love offered to find Pits gratuitously at the due season for planting.

On the motion of Mr. Love it was unanimously agreed to advise the Overseers to pay the Sjeton Receipt.

 Edmonds which proposition was agreed to
