This is the last Will and Testament of me,
Robert Rising of Horry in the County of Norfolk Esquire I
appoint Elizabeth my Wife and my Sons Charles Compton Rising
and Thomas Alfred Rising Executors hereof And I also appoint
the said Charles Compton Rising and Thomas Alfred Rising to be
the Trustees of this my Will And I give and bequeath to my
said Wife All my Wines Liquors Fuel and other consumable stores
and provisions together with all the barnages Horses Stumps and
Stable effects and also all the Plate Jewell China collection of Stuffed
Birds Coins Autographs glass, books, prints, pictures, furniture and
other household effects and chattels which shall be in or about my
residence at the time of my decease for her absolute use and benefit
and I also give and bequeath to her my said Wife an immediate
legacy of One hundred pounds And I give devise and bequeath and
also in exercise and execution of every power or authority whatsoever
given to me by the will of my late Father or otherwise appoint
All the real and household estate to which I shall be entitled
at the time of my decease or which I can in anywise appoint
or otherwise dispose of except estates vested in me as a Trustee or
Mortgagee, and also all the residue of the personal estate to
which I shall then be entitled and including therein all my
Savings Stock and household effects unto the said Charles Compton
Rising and Thomas Alfred Rising their heirs executors administrators
and assigns respectively Upon Trust that they the said Charles
Compton Rising and Thomas Alfred Rising and the survivor
of them and their heirs executors administrators and assigns of
each survivor (whom I have hereinafter designated as my said
Trustees or Trustee) do and shall sell my real and household estates
together or in parcels by public auction or private contract with
power to make any special conditions as to title or evidence of title
or otherwise and with power to buy in the premises at any
public sale and to rescind either in terms or gratuitously any contract
and to resell without being answerable for any consequent loss
And do and shall convey and assign the premises respectively

so sold to the purchasers or purchasers thereof and do and shall
convert and get in my other residuary personal estate and invest
the monies to arise from the sale and commission of such real household
and residuary personal estates in the names or name of my
said Trustees or Trustee in or upon some or more of the
investments or securities following and those only that is to say the
Public Funds or other Government securities of the United Kingdom
or real securities in England or Wales and not elsewhere with
liberty for my said Trustees or Trustee to vary and transpose such
investments from time to time for any other investments of the
description aforesaid And Upon further Trust just and out of the
interest and income of the said Trust monies to pay to my dear
and faithful Steward Thomas Goose for and during the term of
his natural life the sum of Ten shillings a week to be payable
and paid weekly and the first payment thereof to commence
and be made on the first Saturday of the month next following
my decease And subject thereto Upon trust to permit and empower
my said Wife to receive the annual income of the said monies
or the stocks funds and securities wherein the same shall be
invested during her life and after her death it is my will and
I direct that my said Trustees and Trustee shall stand and be
responsible of the said Trust monies and the subsequent interest
and income thereof In trust for such of my five children Emily
Caroline Frederick Robert Arthur Rising Charles Compton Rising
Thomas Alfred Rising and Henry Alexander Rising as shall
survive me and the issue of such of them as shall die in my
lifetime having issue (such issue nevertheless taking only equally
between them if more than one what would otherwise have been
the parents share) and their respective executors administrators
and assigns And I expressly declare that the share of my said
daughter Emily Caroline Frederick shall be paid to and be
received enjoyed and disposed of by her as her separate estate
without the control or interference of her present or any future
husband and that her receipts alone shall notwithstanding her
decease be effectual discharges for the same Provided always and
I hereby expressly declare that no sale of my real estate or any

part thereof shall be made in the lifetime of my said wife -
without her previous consent in writing and that after her decease
my said Trustees or Trustee may postpone the sale and conversion
of my said real estate or any part or parts thereof for so long a time
as they or he shall think fit but the said real estate and
outstanding personal estate shall be subject to the trusts and equities
hereinbefore contained concerning the monies stocks funds and
securities aforesaid and the net rents and yearly produce thereof
shall be deemed annual income for the purposes of such trusts
and such real estate shall be transmissible as personal estate
under the will of my said Trustee hereinbefore contained And I empower
my said Trustees ^{or Trustee} to devise any hereditaments for the time being -
whosoever either from year to year or for any term of years not exceeding
seven years in possession as such rents and subject to such covenants
as they or he shall think fit and to accept surrenders of leases
and tenancies and generally to manage the said hereditaments
as they or he shall think best And I hereby empower my
said Trustees or Trustee with the consent of my said wife during
her life to present their aforesaid nominees to the Vicarage of Hovey
aforesaid on the first or any other avoidance thereof prior to the
sale of the same Provided also and I hereby expressly declare my
mind and will to be that all such sums and sums of money
as I shall have paid to any one or more of my said children
for their advancement or betterment in life or in marriage and
which may have been placed to their debit in any books of
account and also all such sum or sums of money as shall
be payable and paid out of my estate under any covenant or
other obligation on my part to discharge the same shall in
accordance to the amount thereof be taken either in full or in
part in satisfaction as the case may be of his her or their portion
or portions under this my Will And I devise all real estates
vested in me as a Trustee or mortgagee to the said Charles -
Compton Rising and Thomas Alfred Rising their heirs and
assigns subject to the equities affecting the same respectively And
I empower the Executors and also the Trustees or Trustee for the
time being of this my Will to give receipts for all monies and

effects to be paid & delivered to them respectively by virtue of this my Will and declare that such receipts shall exonerate the persons taking the same from all liability to see to the application or disposition of the monies or effects therein mentioned. And I declare that if any said Trustee Charles Conynton Rising and Thomas Alfred Rising or either of them shall die in my lifetime or if they or either of them or any persons or persons to be appointed under this clause or by a Court of competent jurisdiction or otherwise according to Law shall after my death die or be unwilling incompetent or unfit to execute the trusts of this my Will or desire to retire from the office it shall be lawful for my said Wife during her life and after her death for the competent Trustee or Trustees for the time being if any whether retiring from the office of Trustee and if none for the acting Executor or Executors for the time being or the Administrator or Administrators for the time being of the Test surviving Trustee to substitute by any writing under her his or their hand and hands any fit person or persons in whom alone or as the case may be jointly with the surviving or continuing Trustee or Trustee my Trust Estate shall vest or by proper assurances be vested. And I revoke all former Wills and declare this only to be my last Will and Testament.

In witness whereof unto this my last Will and Testament contained and written on four sheets of papers together annexed I the abovesaid Robert Rising the Testator have to each sheet hereof set my hand this seventeenth day of December one thousand eight hundred and seventy four.
