There were two Charities in the Parish viz The Poor Lane or Fuel Charity of which the Overseers & Churchwardens ^{were} on the list of Trustees; And the Educational Charity of which the Churchwardens were among the Trustees, Instead of the Overseers & Churchwardens the Council could under Sec 14 (2) appoint Trustees

The Chairman here reported that as Chairman of a meeting of the Poor Law Trustees held on Nov 2nd he could announce that a Resolution was unanimously passed by them on the Motion of the Deac seconded by Mr Wiseman to apply to the Charity Commissioners for leave to transfer the Charity to the Parish Council, it was clear therefore that no further step could be taken till after their reply. In the case of the Educational Charity the Chairman pointed out that it consisted of two parts Schedule I and II. Schedule I being an Ecclesiastical Charity.
