 that the only business left unfinished was

 He thanked the Council for the Honours

 the courtesy shown to him by all the
 members of the Council

Mr. Rust proposed a roll of thanks to
 the Chairman for the interest he had
 taken in their proceedings and the
 advice tendered to them in guiding
 the Council to decisions which might
 otherwise have placed them in an
 unenviable position
