that the Pipes crossing road from Main Dyke  
be raised, Have also seen the Footpaths  
across second part of Poor Marsh & would

suggest the removal of Plank between this Marsh & Marsh in the occupation of Mr Bracey. (The Tenant should see to this).

He found the gate which should be hung between the two Marshes across the Dyke and recommend that the gate be rehung & new Post will be required also 3 Rails.
