A Public Meeting

Convened by invitation of Parish Council was held at the Board School on Wednesday the 28th April 1897 to receive suggestions for celebrating Her Majesty's Diamond Jubilee and to appoint a Committee for carrying out the matter.

Mr Churchwarden Pyman on the proposition of the Vicar seconded by Rural District Councillor Jearry was unanimously voted to the Chair.

On taking the Chair Mr Pyman briefly stated the purpose of the meeting; It was desired to receive propositions and to select names to act as a Committee; Other parishes were on the move to celebrate Her Majesty's Diamond Jubilee and he trusted that Martham would show its loyalty by offering propositions to celebrate that day.

The Vicar assumed that Tuesday the 22nd day of June would be the day generally observed, as that was to be kept as a Bank Holiday. He submitted names of Parishioners to act as Committee men with power to add to their number by ballot.
